

 - A Twitter data set stored on S3 (~100GB)
 - Customer requirements
 - Business Requirement (Query types)
 - Minimum Performance Requirement (Throughput)

 - Design and plan before you execute


- What you are asked to do
 - Build a web service
 - Preprocess the data and store them
 - Process queries from customer and send a response
 - Explore solutions to win the bid
 - Front End and Back End
